

Where are you located?

Summer classes for both Coperni 2 and Coperni 3 students will be held on-site at Coperni 3, on the northwest side of the Citadel Mall.

What are your hours?

We are open every school day from 7:00 am - 4:00 pm. Instruction begins at 8:00 am and ends at 3:25 pm each day. As always, before-and-after-school care is FREE at Coperni.

Do I have to be enrolled at Coperni to attend?

Yes! You must be a current student at Coperni or already enrolled for the 2021-2022 school year to attend summer school. Please visit our websites to enroll: coperni2.org or coperni3.org.

What kind of classes can students take?

All students must take a core content class: math, language arts, or both. Then, they may select 2-3 elective classes, depending on their grade level. We are partnering with professionals in our community to help teach awesome classes such as photography, bicycling, basketball, choir, and piano, as well as our usual elective offerings like dance, art, P.E., and karate.



Will summer classes be offered online?

No, this year all classes for 5th Quarter will be held live and in-person at Coperni 3. If you have extenuating circumstances and must keep your kids at home, but still wish to sign up for summer classes, please contact your school administrators to discuss your options.

How long is each class?

Each class for grades 2-8 is one hour and 20 minutes long.

What about social distancing?

As much as possible, we will strive to remain socially distant and spread apart by 6 feet this summer. To help maintain a safe environment, class sizes will be capped at 20 students per class. We will also continue to require masks to be worn by our students and staff. All teachers and staff (with very few exceptions) will be vaccinated for COVID-19 by the first day of summer school, 22 June.

Will you serve breakfast and lunch?

Yes! Breakfast will be served before instruction begins, from 7:00 am - 8:00 am. Lunch times vary per grade. Please refer to the schedule.

What is your attendance policy?

Due to the cost of running a summer program, we will automatically withdraw a student who misses more than 4 days of any class. If you have extenuating circumstances, please contact your school administrators to discuss your options. We will work with you.
